DECEMBER 6, 2022

Board convened at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chairman Robert Marmon, Commissioner Andy Gates and Commissioner Jamee Hansen.

The Auditor, acting as Chairperson, called for nominations for Board Chairman. Comm. Hansen nominated Comm. Marmon. No other nominations were made. Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates that nominations cease and that a unanimous ballot be cast for Comm. Marmon as Board Chairman. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. Chrm. Marmon called for nominations for Vice-Chairman. Comm. Hansen nominated Comm. Gates. No other nominations were made. Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Marmon that nominations cease and that a unanimous ballot be cast for Comm. Gates as Vice-Chairman. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Sheriff Roger Hutchinson met with the Board. He discussed 2023 budget numbers for his department. Deputy Bryant Beauger resigned as of December 31, 2022. Sheriff Hutchinson will fill the position as soon as possible.

Correspondence addressed to the Board's attention was reviewed and discussed. November payroll was reviewed and filed. Officers reports were reviewed and filed.

Kristy Titus, DES Coordinator, discussed the County's burn policy with the Board. The State recommended the County rescind the policy till it is needed again. Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen to rescind the County burn policy as of today. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Auditor Pollman discussed various funding sources from the State and the Federal government including the "Prairie Dog" funds, COVID funds and the Local Assistance & Tribal Consistency Fund dollars.

Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates to move \$225,000.00 from Gate City Bank to First Western Bank. The funds will be put into a certificate of deposit for a one year term at a 3.75 interest rate. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

The Board discussed property the County received through 3 Year Tax Action. There are 5 lots in Tolley City that the City could buy from the County. Auditor Pollman is waiting to hear from Tolley City.

Sean Mattern, Road Supervisor, gave the Board an update on his department. All three trucks are up and running. The wings have been put on the motorgraders. Sean has a supply of salted sand at the Mohall shop. The NDDOT requested weight limit signs put up at two bridges. The Board discussed the motorgrader operator position that is still open at the Tolley shop. Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen to advertise for the position. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

The Board attended a Zoom meeting with Recorder/Clerk of Court Danielle Petersen on Friday, December 16, 2022. The topic concerned the State wanting to make all County Clerks of Court state employees. This will be discussed in the upcoming legislative session. Danielle gave the Board two examples of resolutions against the proposal. The Board will send them to States's Attorney Seymour Jordan for an opinion.

Tami Aberle, Danielle Petersen, Kristy Titus and Renae Johnson met with the Board to discuss the County's current storm policy. Sheriff Hutchinson was also present for part of the discussion. They would like clarification on when employees are notified of delayed start or closures due to the weather. One suggestion was to follow the MLS School closures. Comm. Marmon stated that with remote learning the school can more easily close than the County. The group would like to have some guidance by 6:30 a.m. because some employees have to be at work by 8:00 a.m. Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen to have an automatic delayed opening (10:00 a.m.) if there is a "no travel advised" for the County at 10:00 p.m. the evening before. That will give the Chairman, the Sheriff and the Road Supervisor time to decide if the courthouse should be closed. Employees will be notified by 8:30 a.m. if a closure is needed for the day. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. Days considered by an employee to be unfit for travel shall be taken as vacation time unless the Board of County Commissioners close the courthouse because of road and/or weather conditions.

Chal & Rose Brown met with the Board to discuss the proposed drain project filed with the Water Resource Board. He asked it the Board would place themselves temporarily on the Water Board to aid in the decision making for the drain project. The Board did not feel that would be beneficial to the petition process. Voting is currently taking place and will end January 5, 2023. The current Water Board members will follow procedures in place to complete the petition process.
