NOVEMBER 7, 2023

Board convened at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chairman Robert Marmon, Commissioner Jamee Hansen and Commissioner Andy Gates.

Sean Mattern, Road Supervisor, met with the Board. One of the tractors is broke down and one of the mowers. They both should be fixed soon. Farden Construction has finished spreading gravel on several County roads. Sean received two estimates for a 12,000 gallon fuel tank for the Mohall Shop. North Star Ag's estimate was \$37,300.00 and Envision's estimate was 39,483.00. Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates to purchase the tank from North Star Ag. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Auditor Pollman had received an email from Ashley Gulke asking about paving 11 miles of CR#9. The estimate for new pavement is \$1 million to \$1.5 million a mile. The County does not have funds for a project of that size.

Auditor Pollman asked the Board to consider having the commissioner minutes scanned by ArcaSearch. The estimate is \$14,995.00 to scan all the books. There is a \$1,299.00 annual fee to maintain and add to the records. The Board will revisit this request at a later date.

The Board discussed the need for office space for the new JDA employee. They had previously toured the two offices by the Courtroom. Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates to have the Judge's chamber become the JDA office and the judge be moved to the court reporter office. Locks will be changed as needed. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. Comm. Marmon had spoken to Danielle about the need for office space.

The meeting adjourned at 11:00 a.m.

The Board attended the Township Officers meeting at 11:00 a.m.

Board convened at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chairman Robert Marmon, Commissioner Jamee Hansen and Commissioner Andy Gates.

Jason Mayfield, Wold Engineering, met with the Board to discuss grant opportunities and future road projects. He is working on the Ag Infrastructure grant for cement stabilization and graveling on the south 4 miles of CR#7 and then east on CR#26. Estimated cost is \$1.6 million which includes engineering. There is also a Flex Fund grant program that has no maximum and the County could possibly use Federal Aid dollars for their cost share. Letters of support from ag businesses and producers will be needed. Jason said the Safety Projects with the NDDOT have been moved back to 2025.

Sean Mattern, Road Supervisor, met with the Board. The graveling and mowing is done for the season. The tractors and mowers have been repaired and will be stored in the Tolley Shop for the winter. Sean will order gravel from Farden for County roads for next spring.

One person appeared for the Tax Sale. The County acquired four properties due to lack of payment of 2020 taxes. The lot in Norma sold to Greg Gottschall.

Correspondence addressed to the Board's attention was reviewed and discussed. Officers reports were reviewed and filed.

Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates to approve the Court Services Contract with Mohall City. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

The Board met with County Recorder/Clerk of Court Danielle Petersen. The Board was disappointed with an email sent by Danielle to the court administrator, the judge and to them. They felt the issue should have been handled face to face. They discussed the need for office space for the JDA coordinator. After much discussion it was agreed that the center office used by the Court secretary will be made available to the JDA coordinator. Danielle will arrange for locks to be changed where needed in order to maintain courtroom security. Current JDA Coordinator, Kristy Titus, was also in attendance.

Roger Hutchinson, County Sheriff, gave the Board an update on calls for service for the month of October. He informed the Board that the department has received \$23,077.00 thru the "Back the Blue" grant from the State. Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates to approve Sheriff Hutchinson to disperse the grant as he sees fit. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Sheriff Hutchinson also discussed equipment needs with the Board. One of the patrol vehicles needs a new "toughbook" computer. Also, the camera system needs a new server. Roger is looking at grants to help with the cost of the new system. The estimated cost of the server is \$11,095.00. The Dodge pickup will be transferred to the Road Department for their use. The door at the storage facility is being fixed on Friday. The Board received a thank you email from a Canadian citizen Deputy Ann Millerbernd recently helped. Ralph VanOostveen had struck a moose but was not injured. Deputy Millerbernd made sure he had the help he needed to continue his journey home.
