

RENVILLE COUNTY PARK BOARD PROCEEDINGS
MARCH 24, 2026
RENVILLE COUNTY COURTHOUSE

Board convened at 8:00 a.m. Present: Park Board Commissioners Keith Degenstein, Diana Krause, Jamee Hansen, Rick Haman and Andy Gates. Also present:, Karen & Ross Carter, Vera Jones, Deputy Auditor Victoria Klingbeil-Trout and County Auditor LeAnn Pollman.

Moved by Comm. Krause, second by Comm. Haman to approve the minutes from February 17, 2026 as presented. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Vera Jones presented her ideas for the C-Store. She would stock limited grocery items, ice cream, propane tank services, an ice machine, fireworks and cater towards the kids at the Park. She stated the following equipment would be needed: microwave, small chest freezer, coffee maker, fridge, malt machine and pool cues. She will gather information on the needed equipment and meet with the Board on April 7th.

Jack Pung (Pungo's LLC) presented the Board with an estimate for repairing the mold in the South Comfort station. He will remove all damaged materials and replace them with waterproof material and tile. The estimate is \$15,650.00. The project will be submitted to Kenmare Vet's Gaming for possible reimbursement. Moved by Comm. Haman, second by Comm. Krause to approve the estimate and have Jack start as soon as possible. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. The estimate for the plumbing from Matt Johnson is \$2,500.00. Keith will ask for a more detailed estimate.

The Board discussed the estimate for replacing the front doors of the bar. Fargo Glass & Paint submitted an estimate of \$13,881.00 for commercial glass doors with handicapped accessibility. Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates to approve the project. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. The project will be submitted to Kenmare Vet's Gaming for possible reimbursement.

Deputy Auditor Victoria Klingbeil-Trout and Deputy Recorder Terri Reidman gave the Board on update on the on-line camping registration project. Victoria stated that SRT Communications will be going down to the Park to check on internet access.

The Board received two requests to leave sheds on camping lots. Kevin Marmon and JorDan Lawson made the requests. Moved by Comm. Haman, second by Comm. Krause to approve the requests. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Disaster Emergency Manager Kristy Titus gave the Board on update on the Emergency Plan for the Park. She will see if the Park can get an additional AED for the South Comfort Station.

The Board inquired if Gerry Steen had found any information on the grinder/tank system for the fish cleaning station. Gerry stated the tank is currently frozen. He will check it when things thaw out!

April 1st, MDU will turn on the sites that were turned off for the season.

The meeting adjourned at 9:08 a.m.
