

RENVILLE COUNTY PARK BOARD PROCEEDINGS

JUNE 2, 2026

RENVILLE COUNTY COURTHOUSE

Board convened at 8:30 a.m. Present: Park Board Commissioners Keith Degenstein, Jamee Hansen, and Andy Gates. Absent: Diana Krause and Rick Haman. Also present: Vera Jones and County Auditor LeAnn Pollman.

Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates to approve the minutes from May 5, 2026 as presented. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Renae Johnson, 9-1-1 Coordinator, met with the Board to discuss identification posts needed at all the campsites. The estimate for the posts and decals is \$8,700.00. Each post would identify the campsite by number and have a slide that would indicate "reserved" or "available". She would need approximately 128 posts. Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen to approve the purchase. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. Gerry and Jody will handle the installation.

The Board discussed the C-store hours with Vera Jones. She stated she will have the following hours: Closed - Monday thru Wednesday (unless a holiday); Thursday 3pm to 7pm, Friday 8am to 8pm, Saturday 8am to 10pm and Sunday 9am to 5pm. She said that everything is going well.

Victoria and Terri entered the meeting.

The Board reviewed the quote for updating the wifi in the Park received from SRT. Victoria gave the Board a breakdown of the work requested. Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen to approve the quote and get the work done as soon as possible! Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. The ADM would also be connected at the south comfort station.

Fargo Glass installed the new bar doors last week. Northland Electric has finished the electrical work for the new doors also. Auditor Pollman will submit the bills to Kenmare Vet's Gaming for possible reimbursement.

The Board asked Auditor Pollman to check on the pickleball court sealing project.

The Board will talk to Sean Mattern about getting gravel on the church road.

The Board discussed a list presented by Victoria and Terri concerning the Park. Victoria asked about the dates for the 2027 season. The Board thought that having January and February 2027 as the timeframe for year round/seasonal campers to make their reservations. As of March 1, the campsites would be open to everyone. There are two concrete picnic pads that need replacing. Keith will talk to Reon Bernsdorf and get a quote. Victoria and Terri suggested having a registration station at the MRP office. The Board liked the idea. They will get a tablet and secure stand for this use. Victoria had researched the sign on Hwy 5. The Board would like to place the sign at the corner of Hwy 5 and the road to the Park. They asked her to get a price for a two sided sign.

The Board also discussed the grease disposal site at the bar. They want it all removed.

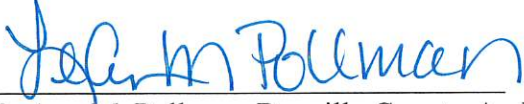
Gerry will take care of that.
