

RENVILLE COUNTY PARK BOARD PROCEEDINGS  
AUGUST 4, 2026  
RENVILLE COUNTY COURTHOUSE

Board convened at 8:00 a.m. Present: Park Board Commissioners Keith Degenstein, Diana Krause, Rick Haman, Jamee Hansen and Andy Gates. Also present: Gerry Steen, Victoria Klingbeil-Trout, Danny Schlosser and County Auditor LeAnn Pollman.

Moved by Comm. Krause, second by Comm. Gates to approve the minutes from July 7, 2026 as presented. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Gerry Steen stated he had recycled some of the pieces of the broken cement slab from the picnic canopy to use for a sidewalk for the pickleball court. The net is scheduled to be installed this week.

Danny Schlosser and the Board discussed the bar lease for 2027. Neither party had any problems with the current lease. Danny would like to have the lease review done in August each year so he can book bands for the following season. The Auditor's office will conduct an inventory in December for the bar. Gerry has been working on a drain issue with the bar. Danny will contact Circle Sanitation to have his own garbage service. The two Waste Management dumpsters will be placed elsewhere in the park.

Moved by Comm. Haman, second by Comm. Krause to approve Danny Schlosser for the bar lease for 2027. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

The Board discussed the proposed upgrades to the fish cleaning station. The funding is not available right now for a full remodel. The Board discussed adding a light and an electrical outlet to the station. Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen to have the light and outlet installed by Northland Electric. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

The Board discussed the sign for the Hwy 5 and CR3 intersection. They decided to check with the NDDOT and ask them to put up signs for the Park. Comm. Haman will check with the Minot office.

The Board discussed the installation of a Comfort Station in the new camping area on Iverson Drive. The first item needed is water. The Board will work on that phase.

The south Comfort Station toilets need to be repaired. Gerry Steen will talk to Matt Johnson.

The tractor has been repaired by Gooseneck Implement and is back at the Park.

The 2027 budget was discussed. Gerry Steen mentioned he will need to purchase a lawn mower in 2027.

Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Haman to pay Comm. Degenstein and Comm. Krause \$50.00 per meeting in 2027. The payment will be made in December 2027. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

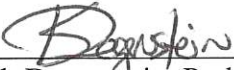
Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Krause to approve the 2027 preliminary budget. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.
