RENVILLE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER 2022

OCTOBER 2, 3 & 4, 2022

Commissioners Marmon, Langehaug and Stanley attended the ND Association of Counties convention in Bismarck.

OCTOBER 6, 2022

Board convened at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chairman Robert Marmon, Commissioner William Stanley and Commissioner Arnold Langehaug.

Sean Mattern, Road Supervisor, met with the Board. He received two applications for the motorgrader job opening. Neither applicant had any experience or a CDL. The Board and Sean discussed adding a township to each of the remaining 5 routes for now. They will see how everything goes with the 5 motorgraders running and address it again if problems arise. Sean and his crew will repair the damage to the guard rail at the Mouse River Park. He will document the before and after of the repairs. They are mowing the roads near Glenburn today.

Kent Indvik, Wold Engineering, met with Sean and the Board. They discussed the next road project. Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Langehaug to overlay County Road #9, four miles north of Mohall and also County Road #20, Glenburn east 4 ½ miles. Estimated cost is \$1.5 million. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. Bid would be let in 2023 or 2024. The "Prairie Dog" funds would be used for this project. Those funds are estimated to be disbursed in January 2023. If the County does not get the funding, the project will be put on hold. Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Langehaug to chip seal County Road #4, Loraine East & West and the Mohall North and Glenburn East projects for a total of 16 ½ miles. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. Estimated cost is \$40,000.00 per mile. This project would be slated for 2025.

Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Langehaug to approve the NW Regional Housing Authority certification. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Langehaug, second by Comm. Stanley that the minutes of September 2022 be approved as presented. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Correspondence addressed to the Board's attention was reviewed and discussed. September payroll was reviewed and filed.

Moved by Comm. Langehaug, second by Comm. Stanley that the quarterly reports for the period ended September 30, 2022 be approved and accepted. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Langehaug to remove and discard item #996, office chair, from inventory. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Marmon to approve an upgrade for the Courthouse elevator. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Langehaug, second by Comm. Marmon to approve the 2023 budget for the Mohall Airport and the \$98,000.00 levy request. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Langehaug to amend the 2022 budget for the Highway Safety Grant fund by \$4,000.00. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Langehaug to amend the 2022 budget for the American Recovery Plan Act fund by \$452,000.00. The total funding was not received by the County until August 2022. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Langehaug, second by Comm. Stanley to amend the 2022 budget for the House Bill 1505 fund by \$950,255.00. The funding was not received until 2022 so was not budgeted for. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Langehaug to transfer the remaining CARES funds, \$15,289.11, from the Emergency Fund to the Capital Improvement Fund. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

The properties involved in the 3 Year Tax Action process were discussed. There is a commercial property in Mohall, a residential property in Sherwood and 5 empty lots in Tolley.

The Board discussed the salary requests for the 2023 fiscal year. Comm. Langehaug moved to give a 4% increase for all full time positions. The motion died for lack of a second. Moved by Comm. Stanley to give a 6% increase for all full time positions, second by Comm. Marmon. Roll call vote: Comm. Marmon - yes; Comm. Stanley - yes; Comm. Langehaug - no. The motion carried.

Comm. Stanley introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption, second by Comm. Marmon. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Sean Mattern, Road Supervisor, gave the Board an update on the activities in the department. They are almost done mowing. They will be fixing and replacing signs in the next week.

Correspondence addressed to the Board's attention was reviewed and discussed. Officers reports were reviewed and filed.

The Board reviewed the 2022 tax year levies for the County.

At 10:00 a.m. a hearing was held to review the appraisals of various properties acquired through tax action. Seven parcels were acquired through tax action. No one appeared for the hearing. Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Langehaug that the minimum sale price stated on the appraisal notices be accepted for the parcels acquired through 2021 tax action. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Sheriff Roger Hutchinson met with the Board. The patrol vehicle he ordered has been cancelled by the dealership and then reordered for a 2023 Ford F150 pickup. The dealership cannot give a definite delivery date, but hopefully sometime in 2023. Roger and the Board discussed ordering the 2024 patrol vehicle now because of supply difficulties. Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Marmon to order a 2023/2024 patrol vehicle. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Sheriff Hutchinson stated that he has two persons interested in being part-time deputies for the department.

The Board discussed the Highway Safety Grant program. The campaigns are for Seat Belt use and Speed. Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Langehaug to approve the Sheriff's department participation in these campaigns. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.
