# RENVILLE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY 2025

JANUAR<u>Y 7, 2</u>025–

Board convened at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chairman Andy Gates, Commissioner Jamee Hansen and Commissioner Rick Haman.

Sean Mattern, Road Supervisor, met with the Board. The crew are doing equipment maintenance. He has purchased some scaffolding for painting at the County shops.

Julie Vetter, UpSkill HR, met with the Board. The County is interested in having a part time human resource person. Julie is a certified human resource professional. She will put together some information for the Board to see what the most pressing needs are for the County. Kristy Titus, Danielle Petersen and Victoria Trout-Klingbeil were also present for the presentation.

Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Haman to allocate the Oil Revenue to the General Fund from January to June; to the Road & Bridge Fund from July and August and to the Highway Tax Fund from September to December 2025. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Haman, second by Comm. Hansen that the minutes of December 2024 be approved as presented. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

At 10:00 a.m., the time set to open insurance bids, Comm. Haman moved that the bid on hand be opened, second by Comm. Hansen. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. It was noted that the bid, from Citizen State Agency, was received in a timely manner. Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen that the bid of Citizens Agency be accepted for inland marine, general liability, and auto insurance. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. Agents Mike Nehring and Mason Nehring were present for the bid opening.

Mason gave the Board an update on the Fire & Tornado coverage for the County.

County Sheriff Roger Hutchinson met with the Board. He picked up the new 2023 Ford Expedition. It will be outfitted soon. Roger would like to use the Asset Forfeiture funds to help pay for body cameras. Roger, State's Attorney Seymour Jordan and Auditor LeAnn Pollman are the committee that approves allocations from the Asset Forfeiture Fund. Roger gave the Board his yearly report on calls for service. He also informed the Board that he named Ryder Donohue and Adam Siegrist as Deputies of the Year for the department.

Correspondence addressed to the Board's attention was reviewed and discussed. Travel requests were approved as presented. December payroll was reviewed and filed.

Auditor Pollman gave the Board a report on the cost per vote for the General Election. The cost was \$10.08 per vote.

Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Haman to approve the Lost Warrant request from Darrell Iverson. Check #10256 for \$20.00 was lost. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye to replace the check.
